#### A Partnership Worth **Waiting For**

Tom Noonan, a longtime collector of Illinois brewery memorabilia, envisioned the brewery as a way to bring his extensive collection out of storage and into the public eye. "I know a lot of collectors with really great stuff, but it's in the basement," said Noonan. "This project was to bring it out so everybody can see it, to have a museum of local brewery history here in town."

Years of searching finally led him to the right space - a former bar and restaurant previously operated by his now-business partner, Jason Butler.





### A Lifelong Passion for Picking

Tom Noonan's fascination with brewery memorabilia began early in life, he and his brother, Pete, would go "picking" together — scouring barns, old buildings, flea markets, scrap estate sales, and beer can conventions in search of vintage signs, bottles, and breweriana treasures. What started as a childhood pastime grew into a lifelong passion. Noonan never stopped collecting, and over the decades he amassed one of the most impressive collections of Illinois beer history in the region. His dedication to preserving this history not only fueled his vision for Sangamo Brewing Co., but also helped transform a personal hobby into a public treasure trove.








